Former Instructions regarding these tarballs

Although they are publicly accessible these tarballs are not for public consumption. They are for the private use of associates of ogopogo.biz. Please respect the copyrights embedded in the tarballs themselves.

This is a collection of python install bundles which I find useful to install on ubuntu systems.

Each tarball here represents an installable (using python distutils.core) and uninstallable python package.

To install a bundle from its tarball: `tar zxvf <tarball> ; cd <installbundle_dir> ; cat README.txt`

To uninstall a bundle: `<installbundle>_uninstall` Always uninstall before installing a more recent version.

All files in the bin subdirectory of the given install bundle directory are installed as scripts. Some installation scripts that are only used during installation but not installed are stored in the 'installbin' subdirectory of the tarballs.

'bin/<packagename>_uninstall' is generated by the setup script itself.
